AURORA

Our Arctic Circle Aurora Adventures provide an opportunity to get out and explore Alaska's Arctic by "day" and then stay out later to look for the northern lights. (Note, we did say day. Located this far north we are constantly gaining or losing daylight. Depending on the time you travel, it is important to know of the potential limited daylight. This doesn't stop us from enjoying Alaska's Arctic – but yes, it may be dark when you get to the Arctic Circle.)

DENALI WINTER DRIVE ADVENTURE™ (2 person minimum) - \$289 / person (PEAK \$329)

Includes round trip guided ground tour south to Denali National Park and a visit to the Murie Center. (includes entrance into Denali National Park – please mention if you have a valid annual Park Pass or are 15 years of age or younger)

(Plus Sunday: Nov 23, December 21 and 28, 2025. And Sundays in February and March)

Additional days during peak may be available as the Alaska Railroad adds mid-week departures. Includes one-way guided ground tour south to Denali National Park, visit to the Murie Center, and return ride on the Alaska Railroad from Denali to Fairbanks. Return approx. 8:00 PM Cancellation – The Alaska Railroad Add-On is 80% refundable if cancelled outside of 7 days prior to the tour date. Non-refundable if cancelled within 7 days of the tour date.

AURORA OVERNIGHT

Our Arctic Circle Aurora Adventures spend multiple nights in Coldfoot, Alaska – directly under the Aurora Oval. Inclusions: Includes guided ground tour from Fairbanks to Coldfoot on the Dalton Highway, accommodations at Coldfoot Camp for the number of nights you are staying, and return flight from Coldfoot to Fairbanks.

Meals and optional tours are not included. Additional nights can be added. Min. 2 required.

Arctic Mountain Safari (can only add to the Arctic Circle Aurora Overnight Adventure) ... \$129 / person Join a guided ground tour north into the Brooks Mountain Range on the Dalton Highway. Learn more about life in Alaska's Arctic and stop along the way to take pictures. Departs Saturday, Monday, and Wednesday at 10:00 AM and returns approx. 5:00 PM.

Enjoy an introduction into dog mushing in Alaska. Meet the dogs, learn how to take care of a team, and go for a short ride.

Departure times vary. Dates: December 15 – March 30.

PLANNING YOUR ADVENTURE IN ALASKA'S ARCTIC

RESERVATIONS

Northern Alaska Tour Company can be reached at 907-474-8600 or 800-474-1986 five days a week between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:30 PM during the winter. During the summer we can be reached 7:00 AM to 10:00PM, seven days a week. Or, send us a message: adventure@northernalaska.com. Due to Alaska's popularity and the nature of our high quality, small group excursions, it is very important to contact us early in the itinerary planning process especially during PEAK time periods. We are available to provide further, more detailed information regarding our excursions, and travel to/within Alaska's Arctic.

In order to make a reservation we would need the following information:

- Reconfirm the date and tour the reservation request is for
- Name of each guest (If you are booking an Arctic Circle Adventure as you would like it to appear on your Arctic Circle certificate)
- Body Weight of each guest we can take it in pounds, stones, or kilos (Not needed for any of the ground only tour experiences)
- Contact Information: Address, Phone Number and E-mail Address
- Hotel while actually not required, we do like to know where you are staying the night prior to travelling with us so we can reach you if necessary
- Payment we accept Visa and MasterCard. We need the name on the card, number, expiration date, and the 3 digit code on the back of the card. Full amount is charged at the time of reservation.

WEATHER ALTERATIONS

Weather can cause delays or cancellations to all or part of your itinerary. If Northern Alaska Tour Company has to cancel your tour departure the tour will be 100% refundable or yes, we will work with you to see if there is another date/tour to reschedule to. If the weather requires us to alter the return method of travel from air to ground it will be done as an equal exchange of travel.

CANCELLATIONS

Once made, all reservations are subject to a 5% cancellation fee. All Aurora and spring season adventures have a 7 Day Cancellation with the EXCEPTION of the Alaska Railroad Add-On (the Alaska Railroad Add-On is 80% refunded if cancelled outside 7 days prior to the tour date). We appreciate circumstances beyond your control may require you to cancel your reservation. If you feel you may need to cancel within the penalty period we would recommend you purchase travel insurance to cover any cancellations which may occur.

CHANGES

If you change your tour from a date within a cancellation period to a date outside of the cancellation period, it does become non-refundable. Fees will apply if you use one credit card, then ask to refund that credit card and use a different one (or multiple different credit cards).

Weather and other delays can affect your travel to Fairbanks for the start of your adventure with Northern Alaska Tour Company and it can affect your return to Fairbanks at the end of your Adventure with us. Because of this we highly recommend you arrive in Fairbanks the night prior to joining us and plan to stay in Fairbanks the day you return with us.
